





Support for Care Home Residents

Advance Care Planning (ACP) in Care Home Team

ACP / RESPECT Workstream

Proactive work designed to keep patients well, in their preferred place of care, anticipating their needs to avoid emergency admission:

- Identification of patients with deteriorating health and a high frailty score and start the ACP, anticipatory care, and ReSPECT.
- MDTs to discuss with wider health professionals around the plans of care for the above patient group.
 - Telford GP surgeries: planned weekly MDT meetings with each Care Home, a pharmacist, Care Home MDT, and Dementia services
 on a monthly basis. These meetings discuss patients that any part has concern about. The patient is then seen by Care Home MDT.
 - Shropshire GP surgeries: MDT meetings on a four weekly rolling programme.

To provide the essential knowledge and understanding to make the best use of the planning and support available.

- Patient and relatives' education
- Education for staff on recognition of deteriorating health, frailty, UTI and chest infection prevention and identification.
- Awareness of ACP, anticipatory care planning, and ReSPECT processes.
- Increasing confidence in Care Homes to accept patients back from hospital.

Care Home Virtual Ward

Stared in December 2022 to support system pressures.

- Contacting Care Homes daily (Monday to Friday) to identify any concerns about risk of deterioration, admission, or issues with existing plans.
- Additionally, referrals will be accepted from any health or social care professional involved with patient, including inpatient settings.
- Considering movement onto Virtual Ward.
- Ensuring patient flows through to ACP / ReSPECT workstream.
- To provide support to patients to avoid hospital admission step up into virtual ward or stepping down and providing confidence to the Care Home in caring for the patient during the step-down process.

The patients eligible for this service:

- Care Home residents (nursing, residential, and EMI).
- Patients registered with a GP in Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin.

The patients not eligible for this service:

- Learning Disability
- Living in supported living/scheme managed
- Referral Routes
- ACP / RESPECT Workstream
- Services provided by existing District Nursing teams, and other specialist services

Support

- Providing advice and guidance on the safe and effective management of medicines in line with CQC, NICE, other National requirements and local guidance such as:
 - Managing medicines in care homes Social care guideline [SC1]
 - ONS Think Food approach
 - Self-Care, Homely Remedies
 - When Required medicines PRNs
 - Covert medicines
 - Controlled drugs
- Where concerns around medicines safety issues in care homes are raised -- work closely with all stakeholders including Local Authorities.
- Supporting care homes with medicines management elements of other projects such as falls prevention, Hydration & UTIs.
- To report and support investigation for medicines safety incidents in line with ICB procedures, sharing learnings from incident investigations to promote best practice and inform training.
- Supporting Safeguarding teams where medicines management advice is required following a safeguarding referral.
- Support with medication ordering processes and waste management.
- To work with GP practice teams and Community Pharmacies to improve processes around medicines ordering supporting timely access to patients' medicines.
- Supporting Primary Care and community pharmacy with relationship building / linking with Care Homes
