

Support for people with a learning disability and autistic people – The Transforming Care Service



Our service, sometimes called the TCP service, is for people with a learning disability and/or autistic people. It supports you to

- Have a home in your community.
- Get the support you need to live a healthy, safe and fulfilling life.



How do we do this?

- We keep a register called the Dynamic Support Register which has information about people who need support.
- We organise meetings to make sure the right support from our partner organisations is in place.
- Partner organisations are the NHS, Shropshire Council, Telford Council and Barnardo's.

Who is the Dynamic Support Register for?



- People of any age with a learning disability and/or autistic people
- People who are having a difficult time with where they live and their current support.
- People who need extra support to live a healthy, safe and fulfilling life in the community and not go to hospital if they do not need to.



Have my Say



- The people running the Register may call a meeting called a Care and Treatment Review (CTR).
- If you go to school or college, it is called a Care, Education and Treatment Review (CETR)
- You and your parents or carers will be invited to attend if you want to.

If you are under 25 years old, you may be offered a Keyworker. Your keyworker can

- Help you to get the right support.
- Help you to have your say about what you want.



Our Shropshire and Telford Keyworkers are based within a charity called Barnardo's.



How do it get my name on the register?

- Your social worker, mental health worker or another professional may ask you if you would like your name added to the Register.
- Or you or your parent carer can ask for your name to be added. This is called self-referral.
